

iPhone - How to tether to your iPhone

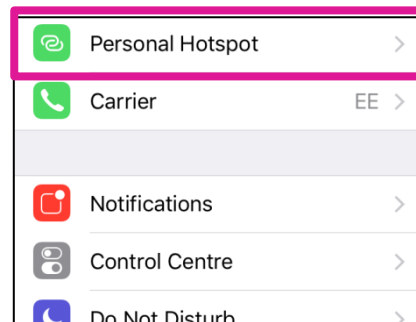
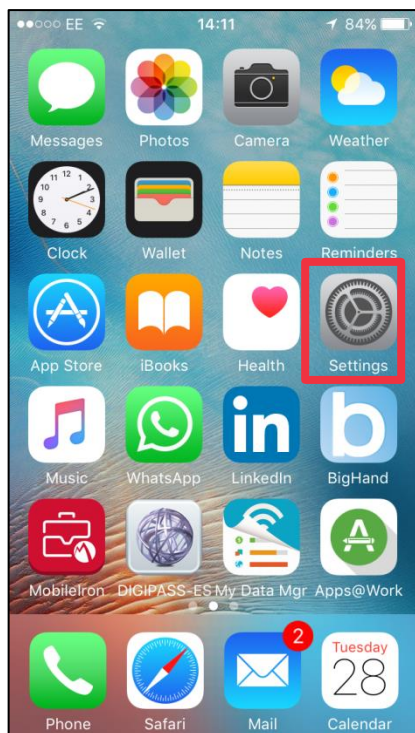
This document outlines how to use your iPhone as a personal hotspot to connect your laptop to the internet. This process is termed tethering.

Tethering to the iPhone is only permitted in conjunction with a Burgess Salmon provided device.

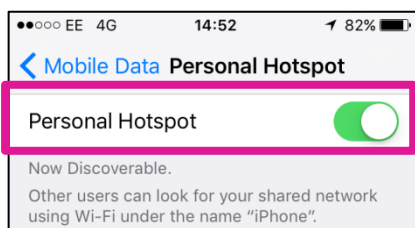
While devices are tethered to your iPhone, you can continue to use the phone as normal to make and receive calls, send text messages and use apps

1 HOW TO TURN YOUR IPHONE INTO A PERSONAL HOTSPOT

1.1 First Tap **Settings**, followed by **Personal Hotspot**



1.2 In the **Personal Hotspot** menu, turn Personal Hotspot on.

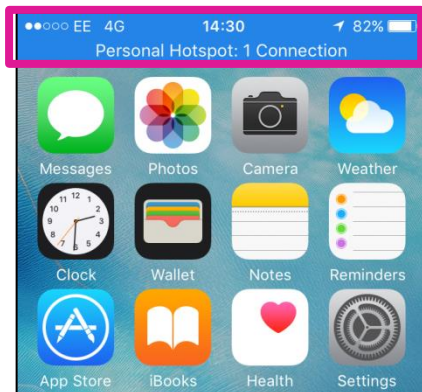


2 CONNECTING A DEVICE VIA WIFI

- 2.1 On the device you wish to connect, search for your iPhone in the list of available Wi-Fi networks. The network will be listed under the name of your iPhone, normally this will be your Burges Salmon user name but in this case 'iPhone'.
- 2.2 Select the network and enter the Personal Hotspot password as shown on your phone in the Personal Hotspot menu.



- 2.3 It is recommended that you use a secure Wi-Fi password, this can be personalised by selecting the Wi-Fi password as shown above.
- 2.4 Once your device is connected a blue banner will display on your iPhone indicating the number of connected devices



- 2.5 It is recommended that while the iPhone is being used as a personal hotspot it is connected to a power socket if available.
